01 Free help with court forms and steps

California Courts self-help centers provide free legal information and help with court forms and procedures for people without a lawyer, regardless of income. Services vary by court. Staff do not act as your lawyer or provide personal legal advice. Both sides may use the same center, and communications are not attorney-client privileged.

02 Help looking for free or low cost legal services

LawHelpCA helps you find legal-aid organizations and other legal resources. Search for family-law help in your area. Each organization decides who it can assist based on its rules, location, type of case and available resources. A listing does not guarantee a free lawyer.

03 Help finding a family law lawyer

The State Bar of California lists certified lawyer-referral services. Use the directory to find services by county, legal issue and language. Ask about consultation and representation fees before you agree to anything. This is not a promise of free representation. The State Bar certifies these services but does not operate them directly. Each referral service sets its own fees and procedures.

What to have nearby

- The county where your case is filed, if a case has started.
- Any papers you received and any hearing or response dates shown on them.
- A short description of the help you want and a list of your questions.
- Your preferred language and a safe way for the organization to contact you.

The organization may ask about income, household size or other eligibility details through its own intake process. Do not send those details to Fast Divorce just to use this resource page.

Los Angeles County. Its courthouse Self-Help Legal Access Centers help people representing themselves with divorce, custody, visitation and parentage. Self-help assistance does not mean an attorney will appear for you. Other legal services require separate screening.

Orange County and designated Southeast Los Angeles communities. Family-law help may include divorce, custody, visitation, support, parentage and restraining orders. Income, assets and service-area screening apply. Representation is considered case by case. Contact the organization before visiting.
